

Visitor Health and Safety Responsibilities

Welcome to Canterbury Foundation!

Thanks for visiting our community. While onsite, we all share the responsibility of ensuring that our residents, staff, visitors, volunteers and contractors can arrive and leave healthy and safe.

As a visitor, to ensure the health and safety of everyone, you are required to:

- Check in at the front desk and sign the Visitor binder.
- Identify yourself throughout the building to staff members, either verbally or by wearing a name tag.
- Follow the instructions of Canterbury Foundation staff, policies and procedures, and refrain from any threatening behaviour towards staff members, either verbally or physically.
- Comply with all infection outbreak and prevention protocols, as applicable.
- Familiarize yourself with the exits in the building and follow instructions from staff if there is an emergency.
- Avoid visiting Canterbury Foundation if you feel ill to prevent the possibility of spreading illness among others.
- Behave in a manner that does not put staff, residents, volunteers, other visitors or contractors in danger.
- Only enter areas of the building that are publicly accessible or the private spaces of the person whom you are visiting in the building, with their permission.
- **Keep any visiting pets leashed or crated** at all times while in public spaces. Be aware of possible hazards throughout the building, and report any hazards that you identify to a staff member

Failure to comply with visitor health and responsibilities may result in a visitor no longer being permitted to access the building.
